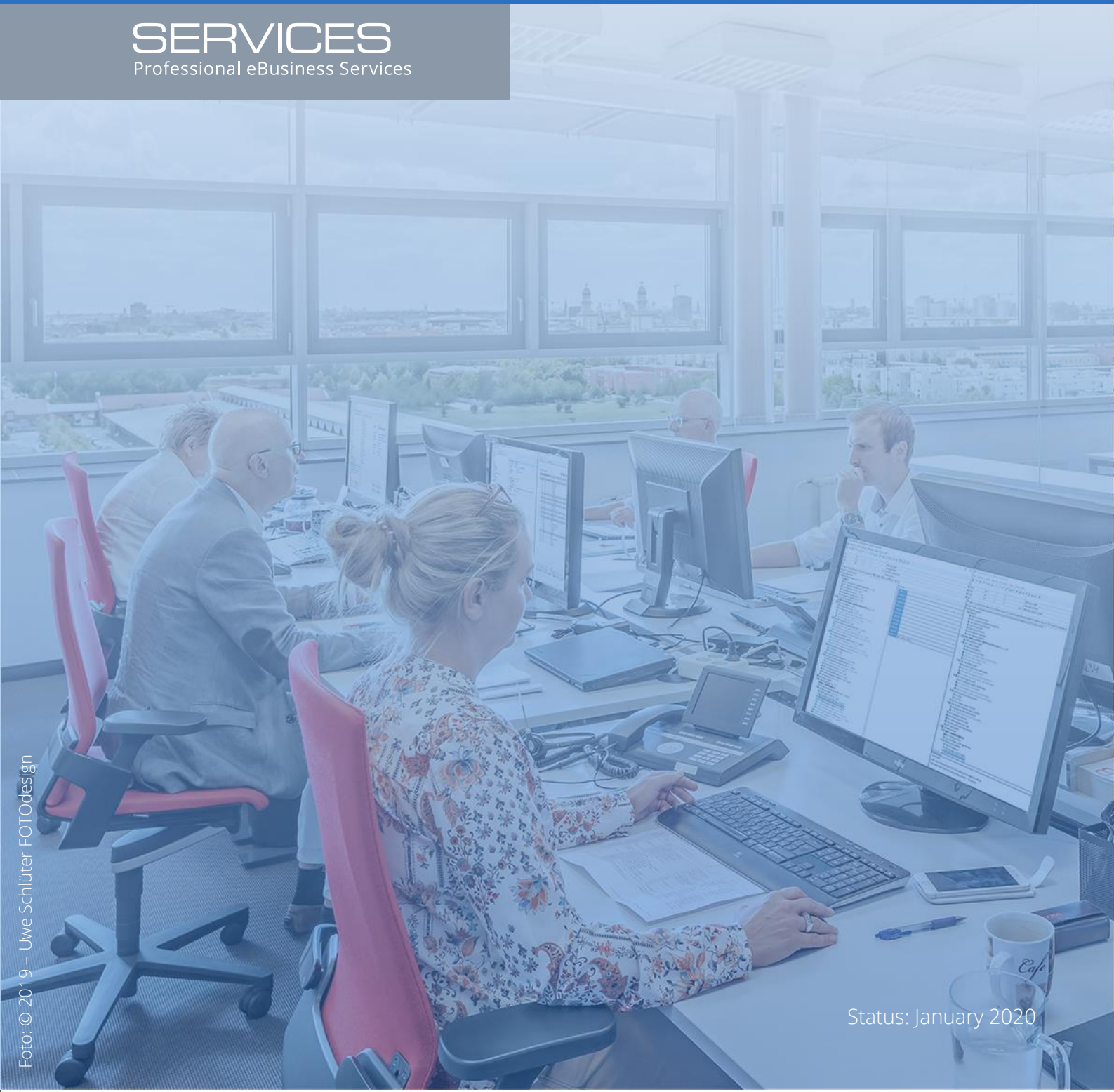

## Course objectives

The workshop aims to create specific, human-readable documentation to be applied for the distribution or publication to partners. Participants will know how to visualize and present their guidelines and test data by modifying existing and designing their own layouts to create a more complex documentation in HTML format. The participants are able to create Word and PDF documentation for a project with different GEFEG.FX objects.

## Target audiences

Experienced users of GEFEG.FX whose requirements are not met by the default documentation at the push of a button, who want to create complex documentation of their GEFEG.FX objects or who have specific requirements regarding their documentation layout.

## Prerequisites

- Participation in one of the courses "Introduction to GEFEG.FX with classical EDI standards", "Planning and applying data models" or "XML schema development" or distinct experience in handling GEFEG.FX
- Basic knowledge of HTML is an advantage
