Specification and Publication of EDI Interfaces

Developing customised guides and their documentation in a workshop

Regardless of whether you use EDIFACT, an XML specification, a data model, another standard for data exchange, or an API interface, the specific application in your company should be described in a detailed specification.

Data exchange with your partners runs smoothly in your company, but it only becomes a real challenge when problems arise.

- Are the specifications of your EDI interfaces up to date?
- Do you have a comprehensible and easy-to-read description for all EDI interfaces?
- Do your current specifications cause a lot of queries from your EDI partners?
- Are you planning a new EDI system and need to migrate the existing data exchange to the new system? Are all format descriptions and mappings available and up to date?

If you answer one of these questions with "No" or "Maybe", you should be proactive. We offer you a customised workshop in which we work with you to develop the specification of the relevant interfaces with the GEFEG.FX software.

Contents of the workshop

In a preliminary call we clarify, for example:

- - Which messages, data formats or guides have the highest priority?
- - Which in-house formats would you like to document?

We then determine which of the following tasks will be undertaken.

- Joint creation of your company-specific documentation on the basis of standards, such as UN/EDIFACT, GS1 EANCOM®, Odette, VDA, IDocs, XML schemas (such as GS1 XML, ISO20022, Factur-X/ZUGFeRD, XRechnung), data models (such as UN/CEFACT multi-modal reference data model), in-house formats, or an API
- Creation of a documentation template for your company
- Consolidate interfaces
- Creating profiles for different EDI partners in one guide



- Capturing and integrating user-defined codes or code lists, e.g. colour codes, special conditions, factory labels
- Create mapping documentation between in-house and EDI formats
- Preparation of the guide to be able to test messages
- Transferring Source and Target Format Descriptions to the EDI System

Results of the workshop

We will discuss with you what results you are looking for specifically, such as

- EDI guides, or schema guides, or data model guides in GEFEG.FX format
- Documentation template
- Documentation in the following formats: rtf, docx, pdf, html
- Optional: Mapping documentation
- Optional: Export of format descriptions for selected EDI systems
